Nurses are not aware of LGBT health disparities and are not able to provide culturally competent care. This presentation will familiarize nurses with biopsychosocial LGBT health disparities, introduce concepts and terminology unique to the community necessary for providing culturally competent care and to teach nurses how to minimize stigma and breakdown barriers to care.

This presentation will enable nurses to identify substance use disorder and its effects in nursing thereby equipping them with the knowledge to intervene and support each other.
