<p><b>Article III</b></p> <p><b>Membership</b></p> <p><b>Section 2. Category of Membership</b></p> <p>a. Dual- Registered Nurses who are members of NJSNA and ANA.</p> <p>b. Direct</p> <p>1. Direct only members. Registered nurses who work or live in NJ may join New Jersey State Nurses Association at the state level only, at any time for such periods of time that direct only membership is sanctioned by a written agreement with the American Nurses Association. This membership does not entitle the registered nurse to belong to or receive benefits from the ANA at the national level.</p> <p><b>Section 4. RIGHTS OF MEMBERS</b></p> <p>a. Every dual member shall have the right to:</p> <p>1. Receive an ANA news periodical.</p> <p>2. Be a candidate for ANA and NJSNA elective and appointed positions.</p> <p>3. Due process at the ANA level.</p> <p>4. Participate in the election of representatives to the ANA Membership Assembly in accordance with the ANA Bylaws.</p> <p>5. Attend the meetings of the ANA Membership Assembly, the convention and other unrestricted ANA activities.</p> <p>6. Attend the Congress on the International Council of Nurses.</p> <p>7. Attend all NJSNA meetings.</p> <p>8. Vote in NJSNA elections.</p> <p>9. Have an ANA membership card.</p>	<p><b>Article III</b></p> <p><b>Membership</b></p> <p><b>Section 2. Category of Membership</b></p> <p>a. Dual <b>Premier ANA-New Jersey ANA Premier Membership</b>. Registered nurses who are members of NJSNA and ANA.</p> <p>b. <b>Dual Standard</b></p> <p>1. <b>ANA-New Jersey/ANA Standard Membership (value price member)</b>. Registered nurses who are members of NJSNA and ANA.</p> <p>c. Direct only members—<del>(Not available for new members)</del> Registered nurses who work or live in NJ may <del>join</del> be a member of New Jersey State Nurses Association at the state level only, <del>at any time</del> for such periods of time that direct only membership is sanctioned by a written agreement with the American Nurses Association. This membership does not entitle the registered nurse to belong to or receive benefits from the ANA at the national level.</p> <p><b>Section 4. RIGHTS OF MEMBERS</b></p> <p>a. Every Dual <b>Premier and Standard</b> member shall have the right to:</p> <p>1. Receive an ANA news periodical.</p> <p>2. Be a candidate for ANA and NJSNA elective and appointed positions.</p> <p>3.
