- NJSNA Region 5 Exhibited/Sponsored NJNS 69th Annual Convention on February 25 26, 2021 with a virtual trade show booth and \$100 basket donation.
- February 23, 2021 Barbara McCormick, DNP, RN, CEN was guest speaker for Saint Joseph's University, Phila PA Diversity Leadership in Health Care Course.
- March 16, 2021 NJSNA Region 5 held virtual education with Gift of Life titled *Organ Donation in the Face of Covid-19*. Annette Conklin PhD, DNP, RN, CNE was the meeting planner. 32 people signed up, 25 attended and 18 evaluations were completed. Excellent evaluations and feedback showed that this was an outstanding educational event. CE application process had various difficulties and more in attendance was desired.
