

Feeling unsure about the COVID-19 vaccine?

Are you planning on getting pregnant soon and have concerns about getting vaccinated?

Information continues to be collected, but here is what is known so far about COVID-19 vaccines:

- The vaccine <u>does not</u> change your DNA (genetic material)
- The vaccine does not affect your ability to get pregnant
- The vaccine <u>does</u> protect you and your family from getting infected with COVID-19
- COVID-19 vaccination is recommended for people who are pregnant, breastfeeding, trying to get pregnant now, or might become pregnant in the future.

Talk to your doctor to see if COVID-19 vaccine is right for you.
